#### **DOJO REMINDERS**

#### Please make sure you pick up your child on time.

- All tuition payments are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month NO EXCEPTIONS. A late charge of \$15.00 will apply; a return check charge of \$20.00 will apply.
- Sensei Oshiro continues to give Kobudo instruction here at the Dojo. Students should take advantage of being taught by one of the foremost weapons instructors in the world. Only \$25 per class plus you must provide your own weapons.
- Per the Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai rules, there will no longer be any rank skipping, unless you pay for each level of the test. This may seem rather harsh, but traditional training makes the student wait at least six month between each level to properly be prepared for the test. This is based on two days per week program.
- The Brown Belt Kyu tests are one year apart, and 100 assisted classes minimum are due before each promotion. A requirement of 300 assisted classes by the brown belt must be logged before allowing testing for Black Belt candidate. Also have to be registered with Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai membership three years consecutive before allowed to test.
- Private lessons MUST be prepaid, or they will be canceled. We are sorry to announce this, but lately we have had an abundance of no-shows, or last minute cancellations. There are no refunds on these types of issues.
- We still have had complaints about people parking in the street waiting to pick up their children. Please pull into a parking place, circle the block, or park in the rear of the school so this does not create an unsafe condition while picking up your child. Thank you!
- Current students are encouraged to bring in a friend in to try out a class. If the guest decides to continue and join the program, the student who referred will be awarded a Tibon's Goju Ryu T-Shirt for the referral.
- Please see Yvonne about any make-up classes you need to schedule. She is always happy to help you! Please Note: Four classes equal one half month which is \$60. Any classes over four is equal to a full month or \$75.

US Olympic Grass Roots Development Program USANKF of Northern California, Inc. Pilot Program US Olympic Training Center Colorado Springs, Col Nov. 21-24, 2008

The USA National Karate-do Federation's (YODP) Youth Olympic Development Program is well on its way this year. The USANKF of Northern California, Inc. Regional Sports Organization for Karate is the pilot program for the YODP

Grassroots program set for the November 21-24th, 2008 at the US Olympic Training Center at Colorado Springs, Col.

RSO President Gene Tibon of Stockton, Ca. with the approval of USANKF CEO Luke St.Onge took the bull by the horns to develop a Grassroots program that will be the first ever in history. Athletes will be developing to become Olympic hopefuls for Karate if accepted into the Olympic Summer Games family in 2016. This program will setup our Grassroots development for our athletes and coaches around the country. The ripple affect of this program will energize our way of Karate to the public, and at the same time develop a higher level of athlete and coaches at the Grassroots level.

The talent at the USANKF Team Trials for Junior and Senior teams will grow to higher level of standard each year the Grassroots (YODP) Youth Olympic Development Program is expanded to all corners of the country.

In China, the country searches for and selects 3 yr olds from around the country, and enters them in training schools until they are old enough to compete in their respective discipline at world level competition. The Olympics in Beijing was a great example of working with their talented youth and creating almost flawless athletes in many different events.

In this Grassroots development program we are taking young talents in the Junior National team pool and pipe line athletes in the Federation to the US Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs to run them and RSO coaches under the guidance of Head USANKF Coach Hidiharu, Igaki. The USANKF of Northern California, Inc. goals are to help with setting up the process to help other RSO's work to develop their Grassroots programs so we can impact the country and help them set up camps in their closest Olympic Training Center. As the program progresses we will have the coaches select some of the top athletes at each camp to attend a special camp with the national team where they will train with the elite athletes to further their development.

The first pilot program's intention is to give 49 athletes and coaches the opportunity to train in the Judo Room for sweeps, take downs, and throws, to the Gymnasium for technical drills and Kumite development, Conditioning and Strength Room, a meeting with Sports Psychologist, and WADA Drug Testing Program on Doping. These young up and coming athletes will be introduced to the Olympic Dream while training, eating, and sleeping at the US Olympic Training Center and taking the Olympic attitude back to their dojos and in their personal training.

#### Just an example of the schedule:

Breakfast 7:30am-8: 30am Olympic training center dining room.

#### Technique 9:30am – 12:00noon Judo Room

• Warm up • Proper stretching • Proper techniques body mechanics, footwork, distance, timing, and mental attitude for both offense and defense. • Ring control. • Strategy: what to do when ahead in points, behind, in the last 30 seconds, the last 10 seconds, and the last 2 seconds of a match. **Lunch: Noon-1pm** 

#### Speed and Conditioning 2-4pm Location: Gym

**Strength and Conditioning** Coach teaches drills and particular strength exercises, along with speed training. Also speed training ladders, cones and small hurdles.

 $\cdot$  Speed training  $\cdot$  Strength training with partners (no equipment). This way the athletes can continue with their training at their home Karate School.  $\cdot$  Talk about amount of practice and the importance of rest & time off training.

Attention students and parents, many times our son's and daughters are getting ready for college and have to take many classes to achieve the grade point average they need to graduate. But it is also mandated that the student have to participate in Physical Education class. We now have an alternative during Summer school, and during school year.

Eligibility is restricted to 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students who need P.E credits towards graduation, maintain full 7 period schedules (no TAs or free periods), and participate in competitive sports programs at the national, state or local level.

Underclassmen whose elective coursework in fine or performing arts does not allow time in the school day to schedule PE may also be eligible. (i.e.band students with full schedules.)

Also every student who has taken Karate as their Senior Project have received A's on their grades. This is also a great opportunity to learn martial arts for a class grade.
