
Sensei Oshiro Weapons Classes

DOJO REMINDERS

Please make sure you pick up your child on time.

- All tuition payments are due by the 10th of each month NO EXCEPTIONS. A late charge of \$15.00 will apply; a return check charge of \$20.00 will apply.
- Sensei Oshiro continues to give Kobudo instruction here at the Dojo. Students should take advantage of being taught by one of the foremost weapons instructors in the world. Only \$25 per class plus you must provide your own weapons.
- Per the Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai rules, there will no longer be any rank skipping, unless you pay for each level of the test. This may seem rather harsh, but traditional training makes the student wait at least six month between each level to properly be prepared for the test. This is based on two days per week program.
- The Brown Belt Kyu tests are one year apart, and 100 assisted classes minimum are due before each promotion. A requirement of 300 assisted classes by the brown belt must be logged before allowing testing for Black Belt candidate. Also have to be registered with Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai membership three years consecutive before allowed to test.
- Private lessons MUST be prepaid, or they will be canceled. We are sorry to announce this, but lately we have had an abundance of no-shows, or last minute cancellations. There are no refunds on these types of issues.
- We still have had complaints about people parking in the street waiting to pick up their children. Please pull into a parking place, circle the block, or park in the rear of the school so this does not create an unsafe condition while picking up your child. Thank you!
- Current students are encouraged to bring in a friend in to try
 out a class. If the guest decides to continue and join the
 program, the student who referred will be awarded a Tibon's
 Goju Ryu T-Shirt for the referral.
- Please see Yvonne about any make-up classes you need to schedule. She is always happy to help you! Please Note: Four classes equal one half month which is \$60. Any classes over four is equal to a full month or \$75.

Regional Sports Organization for Karate is the pilot program for the YODP Grassroots program set for the November 21-24th, 2008 at the US Olympic Training Center at Colorado Springs, Col. was a huge success.

Adam Tibon Being Inducted to the 2009

Adam Tibon started learning karate at the age of 3 yrs old. Like his brother Gino also earned his first international 1st Degree Black belt at 16yrs of age. He started teaching his own junior program of 3-5 year old juniors in our Mighty Mite program, and eventually teaching the more advance Karate programs.

Adam Tibon Special awards: 23 yrs.old 3rd Degree Black Belt Head instructor at GymStars/Tibon's Karate Program in Modesto, Ca., and a Senior Instructor at the Hombu Dojo at 923 N. Yosemite St. Ca. in Stockton. Adam graduated from St. Mary's High School in 2000-2001 wrestled twice in Sub-sections, awarded most outstanding JV Wrestler, awarded most improved, and most outstanding Varsity Wrestler for St. Mary's, inducted into St. Mary's Wall of Fame for Wrestling, played on St. Mary's Varsity Soccer Team, who team went to the SAA Quarter Finals All League Soccer Championships, awarded 1st Team All League Defender for Soccer 2000-2001, Adam also was awarded the City of Stockton Teen of the Month by Mayor Gary Podesto, in 1999-2000. After receiving his Associated Arts Degree from San Joaquin Delta College, he transferred to

University California State Sacramento where he graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Communications in 2007. After 30 days of graduation Adam was hired as **a management employee for Wooseley Ferguson Company in Sacramento** rated 254 on the Fortune 500 list.

Attention students and parents, many times our son's and daughters are getting ready for college and have to take many classes to achieve the grade point average they need to graduate. But it is also mandated that the student have to participate in Physical Education class. We now have an alternative during Summer school, and during school year.

Eligibility is restricted to 11th and 12th grade students who need P.E credits towards graduation, maintain full 7 period schedules (no TAs or free periods), and participate in competitive sports programs at the national, state or local level.

Underclassmen whose elective coursework in fine or performing arts does not allow time in the school day to schedule PE may also be eligible. (i.e.band students with full schedules.)

Also every student who has taken Karate as their Senior Project have received A's on their grades. This is also a great opportunity to learn martial arts for a class grade.
