Regional Sports Organization for Karate past 10 years see www.usankfnorcal.com.

The USA Grassroots Karate Program a non-profit a division of USANKF of Northern California, Inc. see www.grassrootskarate.com was developed to help athletes to become the highest level of competitor in the country. Gene Tibon National Director and founder hosted past USA Grassroots Karate Camps at the US Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, CO. with 50 athletes. The second Grassroots Karate Camp had 100 athletes and coaches, the 2010 USA Grassroots Karate Camp to be held at the University of the Pacific Aug. 6-9, 2010 will be the largest to date with over 150 athletes and coaches from all over the United States.

The goal is to inspire and develop the Olympic attitude of 24/7/365 in their desires to succeed and achieve their goals for what ever they may be. To give these athletes and coaches tools to take to their dojos, and train their students and themselves to the highest level of developmental. To provide technical skills to succeed at the USA National Karate Team Trials if that is their dream. None the less the teach the history and training methods that will help carry traditional Japanese Okinawan Karate and Kobudo to the next generation.

Many of our advance students at Tibon's Goju Ryu Fighting Arts have participated in the USA Grassroots Karate Camp and have won spots on the United States National Karate Team. The USA Grassroots Karate has helped our athletes at Tibon's Goju Ryu Dojo like Joane Orbon and Rupertson Espinosa win a Gold medal in Santiago, Chile for Kumite, Joey Paper winning a Bronze medal in Kumite, Joane Orbon finishing in the quarter finals with best from 89 countries competing at the WKF Jr. World Championships in Rabat-Morocco in 2009 with Rupert Espinosa and Andrew Moore on the World Team. Also winning USA Team spots Brian Embry to Uruguay, Curacao, Dominican Republic, and this year winning spots to the 2010 Montreal, Canada XXI Jr. Pan-American Karate Championships with 35 countries represented are Cristian Embry, Rupert Espinosa, and Joane Orbon, with Andrew Moore and Courtney Embry making the national team pool as 2^{nd} alternates to Montreal.

What made me want to create a USA Grassroots Karate Program, with students like Adam Tibon, Captain for USA to Marseille, France at the World Championships with Robert Lawrie and Amber Ramirez on the Team, Adam, Ronny Guzman, Aaron Silva also won spots to Greece, and Tobago Spain. Amber Ramirez a Gold and Silver Medallist Jr. World Cup in Budapest, Hungary, also to Chile and Netherlands Antilles, and Venezuela, Eliza Cabanig Women's World Cup Tokyo Japan 4th in World, Silver medal Women's Cup in Toulon, France, also a Team USA member at the US Olympic Titan Games in 2003. Eliza along with Adam Tibon, Ronny Guzman, Gino Tibon who all competed at the FISU University World Championships, in Japan, France, and Monterrey Mexico, Pan-American Karate Championships in Argentina, Venezuela, and Canada other major international Goodwill Championships. With our experience we want to pass on our way of Karate-do and impact the country as much as we can through our USA Grassroots Karate Program like we have with our own students. This is our way to give back to Karate-do.

To become a future champion you should be a part of all of the USA Grassroots Karate Program, and our Tibon's Goju Ryu advance Tokubetsu program.

Sensei's Corner

What is Kihon?

Kihon, which means "basics" or "rudiments,", is made up of two characters. Ki means "foundation" or "root." At the bottom of the ideogram is the radical tsuchi, which means "earth." Hon means "base" or "at the foot of." It is made up of the ideogram for "tree" with a dash at its bottom indicating its base. The two characters repeat a single, basic idea. This redundancy is an indication of the importance Japanese place on mastering the basic knowledge and skills of a discipline.

Japanese educators have traditionally believed that only by thoroughly mastering the basics can a student develop the skills and knowledge necessary to move on to more sophisticated, creative levels of a discipline. It is therefore not surprising that a traditional Japanese martial art such as karate also stresses the importance of basics. Like the two characters that make up kihon, basics in karate also work from the ground up. The foundation of all karate techniques lies in the way in which one stands. Karate stances are designed to teach students to fully utilize the lower torso in both training and actual combat. The difficult stances strengthen the legs and hips, and by mastering them you can generate more power in your kicks and punches.

In fact, not so long ago a beginning student of karate would not be allowed to practice anything but a handful of stances. All karate stances can be painfully tiring when held over a prolonged period of time, and the student had to learn to endure this pain and exhaustion before going on to further study. These period sometimes-lasted weeks, even months, after which the student devoted an equally long period to just walking back and forth. Only after mastering standing and walking was a student taught to block, punch, and kick. As you can imagine, this curriculum tested the student's patience to the extreme, Instructors felt this developed character and at the same time weeded out those lacking the mettle to succeed in karate.

In recent years, especially in the West, there has been less emphasis placed on basics. Certainly it would be difficult for a proprietor of a karate school in today's fast-paced society to attract or retain new students if all they were taught for the first few months were standing and walking. However, just as building cannot stand without the proper foundation, and as a tree falls over without its roots, advanced karate techniques cannot be mastered without mastering these basics first. As you are taught a variety of techniques, therefore, you should constantly keep up your practice of your stances and footwork—your kihon, or base.

DOJO REMINDERS

Please make sure you pick up your child on time.

- All tuition payments are due by the 10th of each month NO EXCEPTIONS. A late charge of \$15.00 will apply; a return check charge of \$20.00 will apply.
- Sensei Oshiro continues to give Kobudo instruction here at the Dojo. Students should take advantage of being taught by one of the foremost weapons instructors in the world. Only \$25 per class plus you must provide your own weapons.
- Per the Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai rules, there will no longer be any rank skipping, unless you pay for each level of the test. This may seem rather harsh, but traditional training makes the student wait at least six months between each level to properly be prepared for the test. This is based on a two days per week program.
- The Brown Belt Kyu tests are one year apart, and 100 assisted classes minimum are due before each promotion. A requirement of 300 assisted classes by the brown belt must be logged before allowing testing for Black Belt candidate. Also have to be registered with Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai membership three years consecutive before allowed to test.
- Private lessons MUST be prepaid, or they will be cancelled. We are sorry to announce this, but lately we have had an abundance of no-shows, or last minute cancellations. There are no refunds on these types of issues.
- We still have had complaints about people parking in the street waiting to pick up their children. Please pull into a parking spot, circle the block, or park in the rear of the school so this does not create unsafe conditions while picking up your child. Thank you!
- Please see Yvonne about any make-up classes you need to schedule. She is always happy to help you! Please Note: Four classes equal one half month which is \$65. Any classes over four is equal to a full month or \$75.
