Friendly Reminder: Attention Parents and Students! Monthly Tuition Increase Jan 2011 Please See New Brochures!

Please note, to assist our students and their families during difficult economic times; Tibon's Goju Ryu has not raised tuitions for the past three years. Unfortunately we now find we must raise our monthly tuition, because of our rising operating costs.

Effective January 1, 2011, an increase of an additional \$5.00 per month, per student will be assessed. This nominal increase is less than .65 cents per class, and represents only a small portion of the increases we are experiencing.

It is our expressed wish; these new tuition fees will not present a hardship to anyone, and please realize we always try very hard to give the best value in instruction and investment, for all of our students training in traditional karate and Kobudo.

A quick survey of our local competitors, assures us we are offering quality instruction at a more modest rate, for up to twice the amount of real class-time instruction. Further, we feel we have a proven record of being a karate school that strives for excellence in developing our students to reach a national and international level of development. This is confirmed by our ability to place athletes on the U.S. National Karate Team every year.

We hope you understand the necessity to raise tuitions, to compensate for higher costs in doing business and in order to keep our programs at the high level of technical quality that you have come to expect.

DOJO REMINDERS

Please make sure you pick up your child on time.

- All tuition payments are due by the 10th of each month NO EXCEPTIONS. A late charge of \$15.00 will apply; a return check charge of \$20.00 will apply.
- Sensei Oshiro continues to give Kobudo instruction here at the Dojo. Students should take advantage of being taught by one of the foremost weapons instructors in the world. Only \$25 per class plus you must provide your own weapons.
- Per the Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai rules, there will no longer be any rank skipping, unless you pay for each level of the test. This may seem rather harsh, but traditional training makes the student wait at least six months between each level to properly be prepared for the test. This is based on a two days per week program.
- The Brown Belt Kyu tests are one year apart, and 100 assisted classes minimum are due before each promotion. A requirement of 300 assisted classes by the brown belt must be logged before allowing testing for Black Belt candidate. Also have to be registered with Goju Ryu Uchiage Kai membership three years consecutive before allowed to test.
- Private lessons MUST be prepaid, or they will be cancelled. We are sorry to announce this, but lately we have had an abundance of no-shows, or last minute cancellations. There are no refunds on these types of

Tibon's Goju Ryu Fighting Arts Organization has a reputation of great spirit, honor, and good manners. This reputation is known all over the North American continent. Key points for the new students and parents when you attend a competition.

- Always have positive responses to your child and other athletes.
- Don't be a poor sport, have good manners and shake the judges and the other competitor's hands after the competition.
- Don't berate or put down anybody, whether you agree with decision or not.
- Students after your event be respectful of the other competitors, watch and cheer with good manners.
- Students no running in hallways, playing in elevators, or stairs somebody could have an accident, as well as appear to be very un-disciplined.
- Parents if you see something you don't understand ask one of our Black Belts or Sensei Tibon when he
 is available.

Please refer to dojo etiquette in regards to conduct, dressing, and grooming and health standards. Please no jewelry or

gum on the dojo floor.

In regards to in house sparring we require Mandatory Safety equipment for Kumite:

All gear is to be furnished by the student with the exception of headgear and chest protectors, which are at the discretion of the student or the parent for purchase. Some students like their own headgear and chest protector. Students in color belt class are required the following:

- 1. Hand gear and feet gear.
- 2. Mouth piece
- 3. Groin protection for boys
- 4. Girls can purchase chest plates if desire.
- 5. Shin pads and forearm pads are optional, but recommended for new students.
- 6. Headgear is optional, but can purchase your own.
- 7. Chest gear is optional, but can purchase your own.

Sparring equipment is mandatory for all students it must be in good condition with no cutting edges. Each student must keep nails trimmed and hair clean.

The students will have sparring in the color belt classes. The training is intense and strict no horseplay, or disrespectful attitudes will not be tolerated. No contact to the face or groin is permitted. You may score to the face and groin but you cannot make contact. No contact to the joints is allowed.

The system of rules and regulations enforced, and controlled by a qualified instructors.

At Tibon's Goju Ryu we have very strong traditional ties to Karate in Japan, and Canada, and promote the development of strength of character, discipline, citizenship, good role modeling, and spirit.

Any infraction of the rules will terminate your enrollment.
