2013 Years Recap

January Eight members of Tibon's Goju Ryu organization travel to the 40th STEVESTON ANNUAL INVITATIONAL KARATE Tournament. Athletes in Canada to receive their Black Belts in a special presentation during the tournament. We start new Saturday color belt class on Saturdays taught by Sensei Demytryk and Sensei Rupert. February Tibon's Demo Team preform marching team downtown then martial arts demonstration on stage at the Stockton Civic Auditorium for the Chinese New Year's Festival, and travel to West Coast Shotokan Karate Tournament and win most divisions they competed in. March Tibon's Tokubetsu team travels to Portland, Oregon for the Northwest Classic Karate Championships Cristian Embry, Aleesa Ohata, and Justin Gilmour all win \$500 scholarships to use for Nationals, US Open, and Jr. Olympics. WKF Referee Sensei Chuck Sweigart comes to Tibon's main dojo for Referee, judges, and athlete training with the new WKF rules. Black Belt Banquet at Casa Flores for black belt certification ceremony. April we bring in Sensei Hideharu Igaki former head Coach of Team USA host Kumite seminar for athletes at Tibon's Goju Ryu main dojo. Our leadership and dojo families volunteer to work at the USANKF of Northern California Western States National Qualifier for USA Karate Nationals and USA Team Trials at San Joaquin Delta College. Boosters Club and Tibon's dojo have Annual Easter Egg Hunt and picnic at Swenson's Park for great day of egg hunting and fun. May Voted 3rd year in a row "Best of San Joaquin" for Martial Arts Schools. Sensei Toshihiro Oshiro teaches advance Yamani Ryu Kobudo Seminar at Tibon's main dojo all of our weapons students. June Tibon's Goju Ryu Annual Summer IN HOUSE is great success with the march of the American Flag opening with US Army Reserve Color Guard, July 9 athletes from Tibon's Goju Ryu dojo travel to Greenville, South Carolina and win two spots Joane Orbon and Cristian Embry on Team USA to the XXIV Pan-American Karate Championships and two students Jacob Ruiz and Kaitlyn Gilmour win alternate places on the national USA Team pool finishing 3rd place, 3 gold medal national champions by Joane Orbon, Danesha Thompson, and Claudia Lee. We start new Tokubetsu 2 replacing A Team Training being taught Joane Orbon, Cristian Embry, and Brian Embry, August baby shower at Tibon's main dojo for Sensei Justin Love and Christina Love for baby Justin Love Jr., Sensei Joane Orbon wins Gold medal and Cristian Embry wins Bronze medal at the XXIV Pan-American Karate Championships in Medellin, Colombia, Sensei Demytryk receives a life changing injury to his brain and is hospitalized for a month, Tibon's Goju Ryu families and dojo friends have medical support fundraiser for Sensei D raising several thousand dollars to help out with support and special needs. **September** 3rd Degree black belt Sensei Andrew Moore leaves to Denver, Colorado for college in search for another academic degree, Tokubetsu students travel to Fresno to Quan's tournament then drive to Los Angeles for Sensei David Crockett's Karate Tournament at Soka University winning many medal and experience for that weekend, Sensei Bruce Finister is diagnosed with pancreatic cancer. October Tibon's Goju Ryu Leadership work to support Ajari Cup tournament in Oakland to support Sensei Yoshiaki Ajari Karate pioneer from Japan, which was also a successful day of experience for our Tokubetsu students. Three students Aleesa Ohata, Justin Gilmour, and Kaitlyn Gilmour bring home gold medals from the West Coast Open in Tacoma, Washington; Tibon's Goju Ryu Demo prepared by Sensei Brian Embry for the Carson Oaks Community Church for our own Pastor Paul Stanley, and at the Victory Outreach Church supervised, produced, and directed by Sensei Justin Love. Baby Justin Love Jr. born 10/3/2013 7lbs, 7oz, 20" long is born 4:25am, congrats! November Tibon's Goju Ryu Tokubetsu class 21 students travel to Foster city to Hakua Kai Iwabushi cup and dominate the tournament with 24 gold, 10 silver, 3 bronze medals overwhelming all the divisions including the adult black belt kumite division by Sensei Cristian Embry, the under 18 yr. old black belt Kumite by black belt Justin Gilmour. Tokubetsu students also travel to Dixon, CA to the 12th Annual Ryukyukan International Karate Championships and again dominate in their respective divisions. December we host Sensei Takechi Uchiage with advance seminar at Tibon's Goju Ryu main dojo and black belt testing, the next day the 29th Annual Tibon's Goju Ryu Annual Winter IN HOUSE Karate Championships where we had also a can food drive for needy families, and raised \$2400 dollars for Sensei Bruce Finister who just went through pancreatic cancer surgery for medical and support fundraiser from a \$5.00 per ticket for either one year of lessons from Tibon's Goju Ryu main dojo, or 10 private lessons with Sensei Gene Tibon, black belt Aleesa Ohata was the winner of the drawing. The Boosters Club and Tibon's Goju Ryu families and students host the Annual Christmas Potluck and Talent Show at the Podesto Impact Teen Center we also collected 6 bags of clothes and delivered to the Homeless Shelter on Sonora St., they were very happy to receive the clothes. Now we kick off the year preparing our students with an advance Kata seminar of Suparimpai to advance belts for preparation for the USA Karate Nationals and USA Team Trials in July 2014. What a Year!
